### Circus Parade

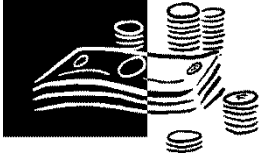

### Budget Sunday

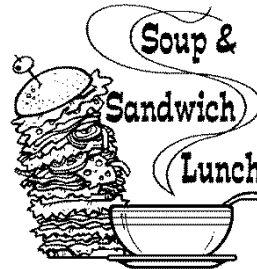
*Please plan to stay following the October 27<sup>th</sup> worship service to review and approve*
